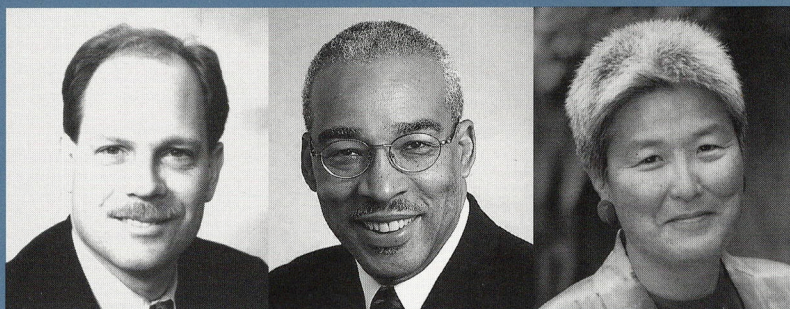
- Intensified course work

Hear from speakers and panelists who know and care. Stand and voice your concerns. Speak from the heart.

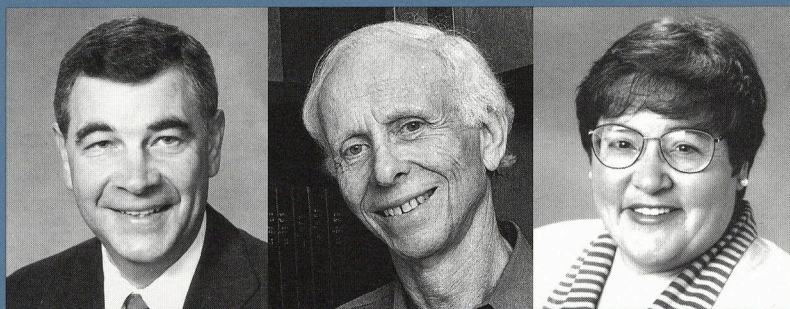
